Members and Guests



GENERAL REGULATIONS

In this section, we will refer to a member, a guest of a member and any other person participating in a shooting or hunting activity as “member.”

- Safety must be a priority for all members.
- Always treat firearms as if they were loaded.
- The use of protective eyewear is mandatory for any hunting and shooting activity.
- It is every member’s responsibility to ensure that safety procedures are followed.
- When you are moving around a shooting station and anywhere else on the Club property, firearms must be unloaded and transported safely.
- Anyone who wants to participate in a hunting or shooting activity must be at least 10 years old, and all minors must be accompanied by an adult.
- Any guests who want to participate in a hunting or shooting activity must be accompanied and supervised by the members who invited them.
- Steel shot pellets are prohibited on the property.
- Only one shotgun per person is authorized, unless any additional shotgun are unloaded and dismantled or unloaded and placed in a case.
- It is every member’s responsibility to keep the property and the firing range clean.
- The use of alcohol or psychoactive drugs will not be tolerated on the hunting grounds during a hunting or shooting activity.
- It is prohibited to use other members’ firearms and equipment unless they have given their prior consent.
- For the safety of all, it is imperative that you comply with the rules posted on the firing range as well as the signs, signals and warnings posted in the hunting area.

Use of Vehicles

- Members are authorized to drive their vehicles to the designated parking spots.
- It is strictly prohibited to park vehicles on main roads.
- If you need to drive a vehicle to your hunting or shooting section, please conduct yourself courteously, because other members might be in the vicinity.
- The maximum speed allowed on the property is 10 kmh.

Dogs

- Dogs must be kept under their masters' control at all times.
- No dogs are allowed inside the Club House.
- For the safety of your dog and other members, do not allow your dog to run around the Club House or parking lot.
- Any member who kills a dog will pay a fine of \$5,000.

REGULATIONS SPECIFIC TO SHOOTING (Clay Pigeon)

- It is prohibited to point a firearm in any direction other than at the target.
- It is strictly prohibited to shoot outside the shooting stations.
- The wearing of protective glasses is mandatory during shooting practice. Wearing hearing protection is recommended.
- When an orange ribbon is placed on a shooting station, it is prohibited to use this station. It means that someone may be within the safety zone.
- Anyone witnessing a dangerous situation may call a ceasefire.
- For safety reasons, no members are authorized to approach or enter into target throwing machines.
- It is strictly prohibited to change the position of the target thrower on the shooting course.

- Only target shooting ammunition authorized by the club may be used. It must be of the type used for skeet or trap, and the shotgun pellets used must be size 7 ½, 8 or 9. No lead or steel hunting ammunition is allowed.

REGULATIONS SPECIFIC TO HUNTING

- Hunting is permitted only within the area designated by the Club.
- The Club reserves the right to have any hunter accompanied by a guide on the property.
- The wearing of protective glasses is mandatory and the wearing of hearing protection is recommended but not mandatory.
- It is strongly recommended that you wear an orange-coloured article of clothing, such as a vest, cap, security patch or coat, etc.
- When you are hunting with a guide, firearms must be loaded and unloaded according to the guide's instructions.
- Any movements around the Club property must be made with the firearm opened or with the safety activated.

Birds

- Do not shoot at birds that are on the ground. Any shots fired at game must be fired safely.
- Hunters must take every reasonable measure to retrieve a bird that is killed or injured as a result of their hunting activities.

Terms, Conditions and Reservations

- Hunting is permitted only by reservation.
- In the event that a guided hunt is cancelled, advance notice of 48 hours must be given. Charges will be billed to your account if this time limit is not complied with.

The Club is not responsible for lost or stolen articles.

The Club is not liable in the event of an accident.

The Club reserves the right to withdraw authorization to hunt or shoot from anyone who commits acts considered dangerous or inappropriate.

Anyone who violates these regulations, depending on the circumstances, may receive a written notice from the Club or be suspended from the Club for a period determined by the Club directors.

All policies are subject to change without advance notice.
