# **CLUB SAFETY RULES**

#### **GENERAL RULES**

- ❖ Safety must be a priority for all members, visitors and guests.
- For safety reasons, any minor child over the age of 10 must always be accompanied by an adult, whether in the clubhouse or on the grounds of the Club de la Roue du Roy. Consequently, we will have to act severely in the case of people who do not comply.
- The wearing of safety glasses and hearing protectors is mandatory on all shooting ranges.
- All members must ensure that when they invite a visitor to the Club, they are not prohibited from possessing firearms and must also ensure that their guest is aware of the Club's safety rules.
- ❖ Do not approach the equipment for any reason. If a machine appears to be defective, inform our staff.
- No alcoholic beverages or psychoactive substances are allowed in the shooting areas, and no consumption of alcohol is permitted before or during shooting.
- Possession and Acquisition License is required for the purchase of ammunition.
- ❖ Handle firearms as if they were loaded at all times.
- \* It is the responsibility of each shooter to ensure that safety procedures are followed.
- The weapon should only be loaded when the shooter is in a shooting stall and it is their turn to shoot.
- Steel ammunition is not permitted on the field.

#### **CLAY TARGET ACTIVITIES**

- Guns permitted for clay pigeon activities are: over & under, side & side, pump and semi-automatic guns. Slings are prohibited.
- ❖ It is strictly forbidden to shoot outside the shooting positions.
- Any person may call a cease-fire if they see a dangerous situation. When a yellow ribbon or a white chain is positioned on a firing point, it is forbidden to use this position. This means that there may be a person inside the safety zone.



- Under no circumstances shall slide or semi-automatic rifles hold more than two shells at a time.
- The guns must always point to the back of the range when loaded. Never point a gun at anything you do not intend to shoot. Examples: walls, clouds in the sky, birds.
- When moving around the field or between shooting positions, a weapon should always be unloaded and the loading mechanism opened.
- Do not hesitate to ask someone to open their weapon while on the move; do not be offended if someone asks you.
- target. It is forbidden for more than one person to shoot at the same target. It is forbidden to shoot at another shooter's missed target.
- The type of weapons allowed include guns classified as "non-restricted weapons". The following weapons are prohibited:

  (i) handguns, (ii) restricted long guns (AR15 style), (iii) unrestricted rifles, and (iv) rifles classified as restricted or prohibited weapons due to the short length of the barrel or weapon.
- The permitted calibers are: .12, .16, .20, .24, 28 and .410.
- ❖ Permitted diameters are only 7<sup>1/2</sup>, 8 and 9. Lead loads may not exceed 1½ ounce.

### **HUNTING ACTIVITIES**

- Hunting is permitted only within the area designated by the Club for that purpose.
- Guns permitted for hunting activities are: over & under, side & side, pump and semi-automatic guns. Slings are not prohibited.
- The permitted calibers are: 10, 12, 16, 20, 24, 28 and .410.
- Only 6, 71/2, 8 and 9 pellets are allowed.
- Under no circumstances shall slide or semi-automatic rifles hold more than two rounds at a time.
- When moving through the field or between shooting positions, a gun must always be unloaded and the loading mechanism opened.
- ❖ When still hunting with a guide, weapons shall be loaded and unloaded upon instruction of the guide.
- ❖ It is forbidden to shoot at a bird on the ground.
- Never point a gun at something you do not intend to shoot. Examples: walls, clouds in the sky, birds.
- ❖ If a hunter shoots a dog, he or she is liable to pay a \$5,000 fine.
